SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our uniform colours are *navy blue and burgundy*. All students are expected to wear the school colours.

Why wear a school uniform?

Wearing a school uniform promotes a sense of pride in how we look and in the school we represent. Wearing a uniform also supports principles of equity. The decision to have a school uniform and to expect all students to wear it was ratified by the School Governing Council.

UNIFORM ITEMS

Unisex

- Shorts - Navy blue
- Pants - Navy
- Shirts - Burgundy / navy blue polo tops with school logo
- Jumper - Burgundy hooded windcheater with school logo

No other colours are permitted
No logos please

Girls

- Skirt - Navy
- Skorts - Navy
- Dress - School dress
- Tights - Navy

Shoes - Velcro or lace ups
Enclosed footwear – toes and heels covered – is the safest option
