HOT WEATHER POLICY

Excursions

If the estimated maximum temperature on the 7.00am news is 36°C or above, most excursions will be cancelled. This includes local outings like walks or shopping at Arndale. Exceptions may be made after a Risk Assessment has been completed and at the discretion of the Leadership team.

If the Leadership Team, in consultation with staff, considers that students are at risk by attending an excursion in temperatures below 36°C, then that excursion will be cancelled.

The Hot Weather policy does not impact the Grove's swimming programme which is conducted at an air-conditioned site.

Outdoor Play

If the temperature at recess or lunch has reached 36°C (or below, if deemed extreme due to hot winds) then there will be no outside play. Staff will follow the current duty roster.

Sun Protection

Parents are asked to apply sunscreen to their child before they come to school and supply sunscreen to be used while at school. Staff will encourage those students who are able, to apply their own sunscreen. Students and staff are expected to wear hats during break times in Terms 1 and 4.

WET WEATHER POLICY

During wet weather an announcement will be made before recess and/or lunch informing staff that the wet weather policy will be implemented.

Staff will follow the current duty roster.
